**Campout:** Our annual school campout will be held September 7<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> (Thursday-Sunday) at West Arbutus Jackson County Park. **All school parents and children are invited.** 

There will be a potluck supper Saturday evening at 5:00 p.m. and a worship service Saturday evening at 6:00 p.m. You are invited to come for the potluck and worship service even if you are not camping.

The campground does not take reservations after Labor Day, but there should be plenty of room for all. You can pick your site when you come out.

**Bean Bag Tournament:** We are excited to have our third bean bag tournament this year at the campground. The tournament will start with the youth singles at noon on Saturday (9/9). We hope to have a youth singles tournament, an adult singles tournament, and an adult doubles tournament. There will be no entry fee; we just want as many people to come and play as possible. **Kwik Trip Scrip:** We have \$50 Kwik Trip gift cards available in the school office. The school receives a discount when we order the cards. This money goes into our Booster Club to support our athletic programs. If you're interested in purchasing a Kwik Trip card, stop in the office.

Breakfast/Lunch Info: Breakfast and lunch will be available every day. Breakfast costs \$2.00/day and lunch costs \$3.00/day. Milk at snack time (Gr. K-1) or milk with a cold lunch costs 30 cents.

We would strongly encourage parents to fill out the free/reduced lunch applications that were included in your summer mailing if you think your income and family size may allow you to qualify. Not only does this help our families who are eligible, it also benefits our hot lunch program. Please turn in applications to the school office as soon as possible. Reduced breakfast price is \$0.30/day, and reduced lunch price is \$0.40/day.

We ask that parents please pay money for breakfasts and lunches ahead of time. We will put that into your meal account, keep track of your child's meals, and let you know when your account is running low. PLEASE TURN IN LUNCH MONEY NO LATER THAN AUGUST 31.
